Leadership Team Responsibilities

S3 Presidents—One senior boy and girl is best. The S3 Presidents are ultimately responsible for the operation of the S3 club. They maintain all communication with school administrators, club members and the S3 adult volunteer coordinator. Presidents must be able to comfortably speak in front of a group and lead the lesson.

S3 Representatives—All grade levels. Like the S3 Presidents, S3 Representatives are eligible to teach the weekly lesson. If the lesson is presented in small discussion groups, each S3 representative comes prepared to lead a group on the lesson. They arrive early to set-up, greet students, take attendance and serve food.

All Leadership Team Members are required to be present and on time for all S3 weekly Bible Study and off-campus leadership meetings and are expected to communicate with Club Coordinator if unable to do so.

Leadership meetings will be scheduled as needed so the Leadership Team and the Coordinator can plan club meetings, go over the S3 Bible study lessons, work on public speaking skills, and share ideas about growing and promoting S3 on campus. In prayer they ask God for guidance. Most importantly, **Leadership Team Members** live out their commitment to Christ and desire for their classmates to know and grow in their knowledge of Him.
