

# **Students Standing Strong Club Constitution and Bylaws**

## **Preamble**

Students Standing Strong clubs provide weekly school club meetings in a healthy and safe environment for all students to connect at school, deepen friendships and learn to make good choices while developing leadership skills. Students Standing Club members are encouraged to participate in school and community service projects.

## **Article I. Name**

The name of our organization is Students Standing Strong.

## **Article II. Purpose**

Connecting students on campus to learn, live, and lead Biblical truth through student-led clubs.

## **Article III. Membership**

### **Section 1**

Membership shall be open to all currently enrolled students who are in good standing with the school.

### **Section 2**

Membership is attained through attending a Students Standing Strong club meeting.

### **Section 3**

Members maintain their membership in Students Standing Strong, regardless of their level of participation, until they graduate.

## **Article IV. Leadership Team**

Any member that is interested in becoming a part of the leadership team is eligible to apply for a leadership position. Current leadership team members vote for the incoming leadership team.

## **Article V. Meetings**

Students Standing Strong meets once a week, bi-weekly or monthly in accordance with the school calendar. Club meetings create a fun atmosphere through socializing, skits, games, and group discussion. Leadership team members meet off campus in order to plan the activities of weekly school club meetings, provide direction for these meetings, and to discuss school and community service opportunities.

## **Article VI. Finances**

Local club expenses are paid out of pocket by the club members.

## **Article VII. Amendments**

Clubs are a member of the national organization, Students Standing Strong. Amendments to this Constitution and Bylaws may be proposed by the local club leadership team. Amendments shall become effective when approved by two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors of Students Standing Strong. All policies of the said group must be consistent with the policies of the Students Standing Strong home office, 1550 Norwood Dr. #208, Hurst, TX 76054.

## **Article VIII. Removal of Membership**

Members of Students Standing Strong clubs are not forcibly removed from the organization. Leadership team members may be asked to step down from a leadership role if they are not compliant with Article II.

## **Article IX. Advisor**

Clubs must comply with school requirements for student-led clubs.
