Take the 2 Cool 2 B Cruel Challenge!

(**Share** your action plan ideas with the group)

Challenge: Your friend gossips about another girl in your school.

Action→

Challenge: Someone you know (not in your group) sits alone everyday at lunch.

Action→

Challenge: A student in your gym class, who lacks ability, is made fun of.

Action >

Challenge: You feel someone in your math class does not have many friends.

Action→

Challenge: You're having a party and your "new" friends don't want you to include your best friend from elementary school because he or she is not in the "cool" crowd.

Action→

Talk About It Read each question aloud and share your thoughts.

- 1. **Who** can you think of at school that shows leadership and is always **kind** to everyone, no matter who they are?
- 2. In your opinion, **what** qualities must students have to be in the "*cool*" crowd?
- 3. **Definition Time:** When students leave others out of their "group" because they aren't "cool" enough, we call that "group" a **clique**. Why do you think students in cliques generally ignore everyone else who is not in their group and act as if they are **2 Cool 2 B Kind?**
- 4. We are **unkind** to others in many different ways. Sometimes we simply ignore or don't even notice people who aren't in our group of friends. Sometimes we even go a step further and "bully" another student! **Give** examples of:
 - a. Physical bullying
 - b. **Bullying** with our words
 - c. **Cyberbullying** on social media
 - d. **Bullying** by ignoring or excluding someone
- 5. When you feel hurt, sad, or not good enough, **how** might that keep you from standing up for someone whom you know is being **bullied**?



- 6. It's hard to love people who hurt us, but God can help! When you truly love, it's easier to be **kind**. **Why** would praying for people you don't like help you to love them?
- 7. **Bullying** hurts! Being **left out** hurts! The world is scary enough. Make it better by defending others when they are attacked. **Read** aloud the Scriptures below and **share** with the group what each Bible passage says about being **kind** and caring for others.
 - a. Ephesians 4:31-32
 - b. 1 John 4:19-21
 - c. 1 John 3:16-18
 - d. Matthew 25:40

- Ephesians 4:31-32 (vs. 32-Kindness Memory Verse) ³¹ Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. ³² Be KIND and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
- 1 John 4:19-21 ¹⁹ We love because He first loved us. ²⁰ If anyone says, "I love God," yet hates his brother [friend], he is a liar. For anyone who does not love his brother [friend], whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. ²¹ And He has given us this command: Whoever loves God must also love his brother [friend].
- 1 John 3:16-18 ¹⁶ This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down His life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers [friends]. ¹⁷ If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother [friend] in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him? ¹⁸ Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth.
- <u>Matthew 25:40</u> (*Jesus speaking*) The King [Jesus] will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers [friends] of Mine, you did for Me.'
